

WARNING: More Storms are Coming!....Do You Trust Your Shelter?
(Psalm 91)

1. Storms are inevitable.
2. Storms vary in duration and intensity.
3. Storms are impossible to accurately predict.

“There is nothing about a storm we have control of except how we prepare for it and then how we choose to react while in it.”

“How you wait in the storm depends upon how much you trust your shelter.”

“You can fellowship with the storm or God but not both.....Whatever you look at will get bigger.”

Why do storms exist?

1. To shape us: 2 Corinthians 3:18; Romans 5: 3-5
2. To strengthen us: 2 Corinthians 12: 9-10; Habakkuk 3: 17-19
3. To test our faith: James 1: 2-4; 1 Corinthians 10:13

What should you do?

1. Prepare ahead of time: Psalm 119:11,105; 1 Peter 4:12-18
2. Seek shelter immediately: Psalm 32:7; Psalm 91
3. Wait in peace for it to end: Psalm 37: 7, 34; John 14: 27; Psalm 107: 28-30

In his timely message he explains that the current “shaking” (or storm) the world is experiencing is not the end but birth pains. Birth pains get stronger in intensity and closer together.

What an incredibly interesting and wonderful time to be a part of what God is doing to advance His Kingdom on earth. We all must prepare and simply “do whatever He says” (John 2:5).
