

Spiritual Bootcamp & More Lesson 5
WHAT YOU DO: HE MUST INCREASE
=John 3:30a (ring finger)

Bootcamp continues as you get armed with more truths from the Word, one finger at a time. By now, the first three fingers of the main hand drill (#1) should be muscle memory: #1 **WHO YOU ARE**, #2 **WHERE YOU ARE**, #3: **WHAT YOU HAVE**. Fingers #4 & #5 together are **WHAT YOU DO**. This lesson you will focus on finger #4 - **HE MUST INCREASE** and learn five top ways for you to grow spiritually, illustrated by a new hand drill (#2).

6. And finally, it's time to end our session by reciting out loud Hand Drill #1 (1-4).

Thumb = *WHO YOU ARE*

Pointer = *WHERE YOU ARE*

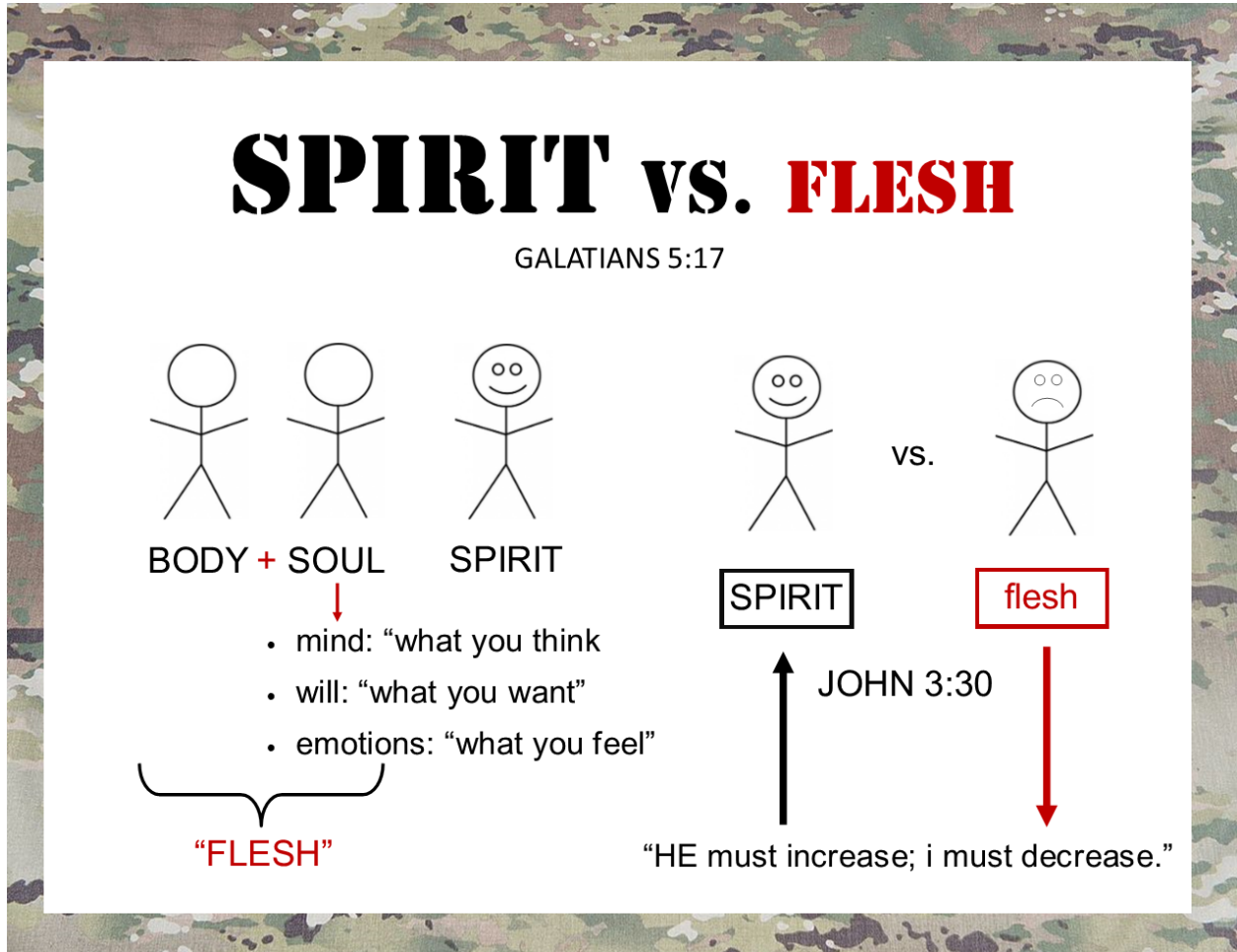
Tallest = *WHAT YOU HAVE (Authority & Power)*

Ring finger = **WHAT YOU DO =HE MUST INCREASE** = Drill #2 = ***The Word, Prayer, Praise, People & Places!***

Pinky finger= *i MUST DECREASE (next lesson)*

Bootcamp Right Hand: Fingers 4 & 5= John 3:30
HE MUST INCREASE; i must decrease.



To summarize the above stick-figure photo:

1. You were born with a **BODY**.
2. You have a **SOUL** which is a) your mind: “*what you think*”
b) your will: “*what you want*”
c) your emotions: “*what you feel*”
3. Your **BODY** + Your **SOUL** = Your **FLESH** (Remember that your flesh will try to line up with the enemy.) You should memorize the components of your soul and your flesh.
4. At the point of your salvation (Holy **SPIRIT** alive in you) the internal civil war began (Galatians 5:17)—Spirit vs. flesh. To win the war **SPIRIT** must increase; **flesh** must decrease.

Fruit of the *Spirit* or Fruit of the *Flesh*? It's Your Choice.

Galatians 5:16-18 "So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. For the sinful nature desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the sinful nature. They are in conflict with each other, so that you do not do what you want. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law."

Deuteronomy 30:15-16,19 "See, I set before you today life and prosperity, death and destruction. For I command you today to love the LORD your God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commands, decrees and laws; then you will live and increase, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land you are entering to possess...I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live and that you may love the LORD your God, listen to his voice, and hold fast to him. For the LORD is your life..."

Characteristic traits/FRUIT of the Holy Spirit: "The 5:22 stuff"

1. Leads, guides, and prompts (a still small voice) into paths of PEACE, always PEACE
2. Humble, meek, gentle, lowly, content, not an "attention seeker," "other-centered," rejoices with success of others, believes the best in others and speaks life to them
3. Speaks the truth, leads, guides, and steers us into all truth, bringing clarity not confusion
4. Submissive to authorities
5. Loving, joyful, kind, faithful, committed, enduring, patient (knows how to wait)
6. Just, shows no partiality, not a "ladder climber," does not compromise the truth
7. Hardworking, goes above and beyond the call of duty, work is marked by excellence
8. Loves God/His Word and embraces the culture of the Kingdom of God

Characteristic traits/FRUIT of the Flesh: "opposite of the 5:22 stuff"

Galatians 5:19-21 "When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, the results are very clear: sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures, idolatry, sorcery, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissension, division, envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other sins like these. Let me tell you again, as I have said before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God."

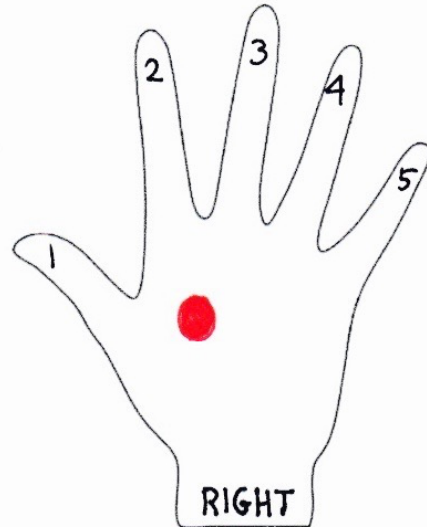
1. Manipulates, controls, dominates, demands, pushy, jealous of and threatened by others
2. Hard, harsh, sharp, pressing, needs lots of attention/strokes, never satisfied, selfish, touchy, rude, resentful, unforgiving, arrogant, "ME, ME, ME, ...It's ALL about ME!"
3. Deceives, lies, confuses, complains, frets, gossips, needs to have the "first and last words"
4. Rebellious, divisive, dishonest
5. Impatient, uncommitted, unfaithful, gives up early if no immediate results
6. Compromises and mediocre at best, when it comes to work "just enough to get by" fits
7. Loves the world and the things of this world, embraces the culture of this world

1. **The WORD***—always #1 way to grow
2. **Prayer***—“points” you to Jesus
3. **Praise***— “highest” (tallest)
4. **People**— (ring finger)
5. **Place**—(pinky finger)

Scriptures below to look up. Transfer to index cards those the Holy Spirit highlights and meditate on them. Get in the Word so it will get into you!

1. The WORD: It is God! It is ALIVE & Powerful! Meditate on it morning & night.
John 1:1, Hebrews 4:12, Revelation 19:13, Joshua 1:8, Isaiah 55:11

2. Prayer: Prayer is your relationship with Jesus. Pray first, early, often. Pray “in the Spirit” frequently; your prayer language is hidden from the enemy—like a stealth bomber! 1
Thessalonians 5:17, Colossians 4:2, Romans 8:26-27, Jude 20, Matthew 6:9-13

3. Praise: “Silences & drives the enemy out.” “He inhabits your praise.” “Praise & be raised!”
Hebrews 13:15, Acts 16:25-26, Psalms 8:2; 22:3; 145-150, 2 Chronicles 20:12-25

4. People: “He who walks with the wise grows wise.” “Where two or three are gathered in My Name...” “Iron sharpens iron.” “If one can chase a thousand, two can put ten thousand to flight!”
Proverbs 13:20, 27:17, Deuteronomy 32:30

5. Places: Seek His Presence/Shelter of the Most High, Life-giving atmospheres give LIFE!
