- 3. <u>Joy</u>: Psalm 16:11 "You have made known to me the path of life, you fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand."
- 4. <u>Rest</u>: Exodus 33:14-15 "The LORD replied, 'My Presence will go with you and I will give you rest.' Then Moses said to him, 'If your Presence does not go with us, do not send us up from here.' " Matthew 11:28-30 "Come unto me, all of you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
